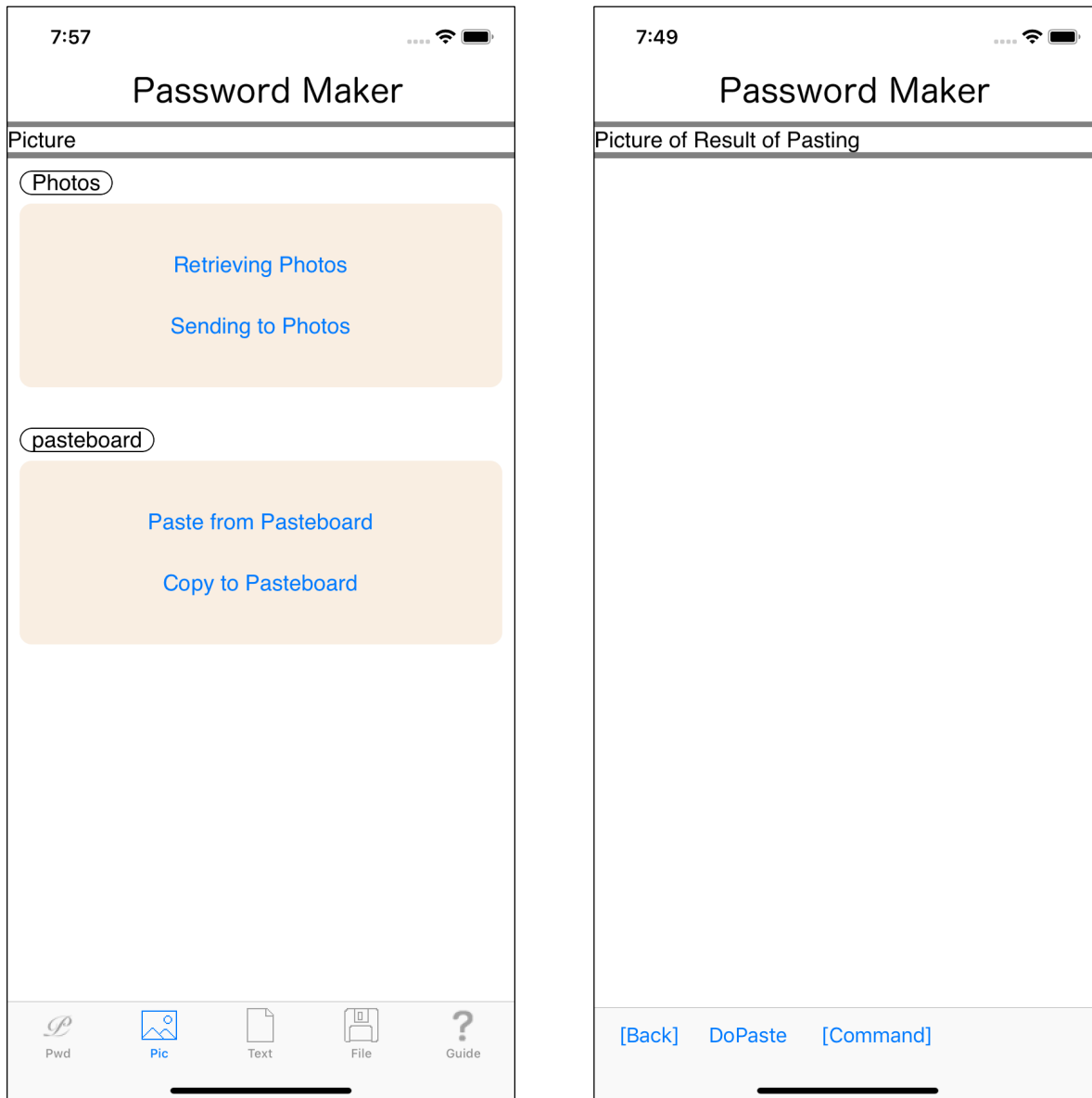


Paste from Pasteboard

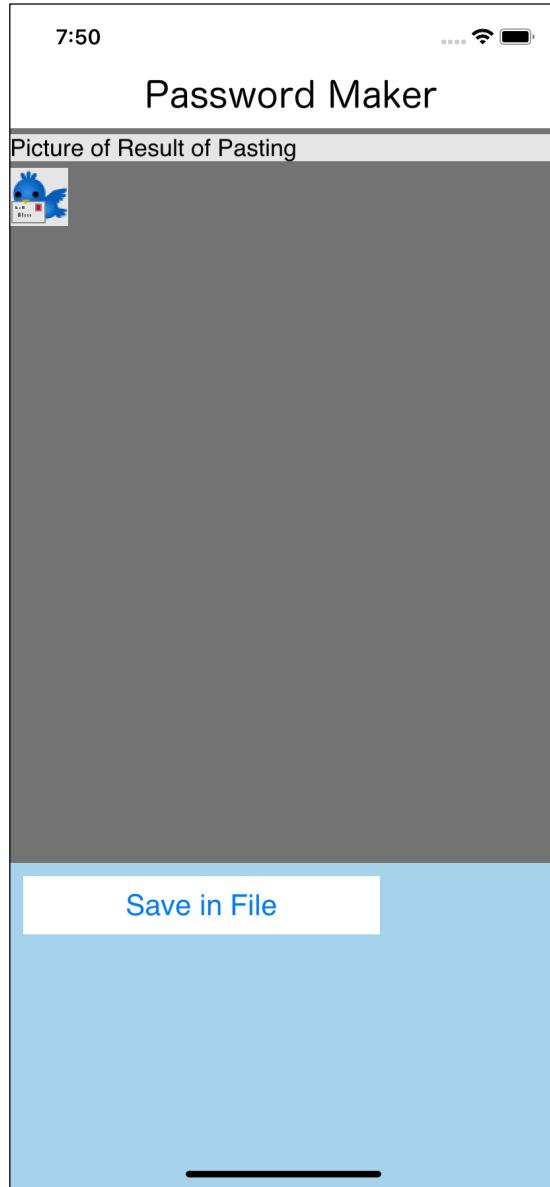
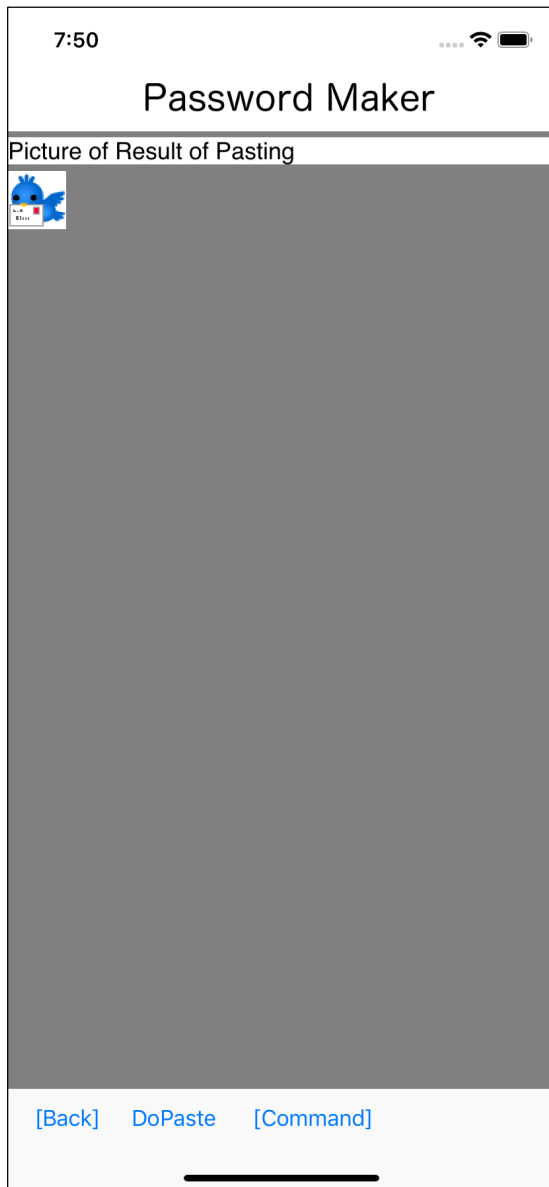


Press the main “Paste from Pasteboard” button in this part, and the right view will appear.

This view is a view that displays an image.

At first, the image to display is not loaded, so it is blank.

When you press the “DoPaste” button on the toolbar, the pasteboard image is pasted to the image display view.



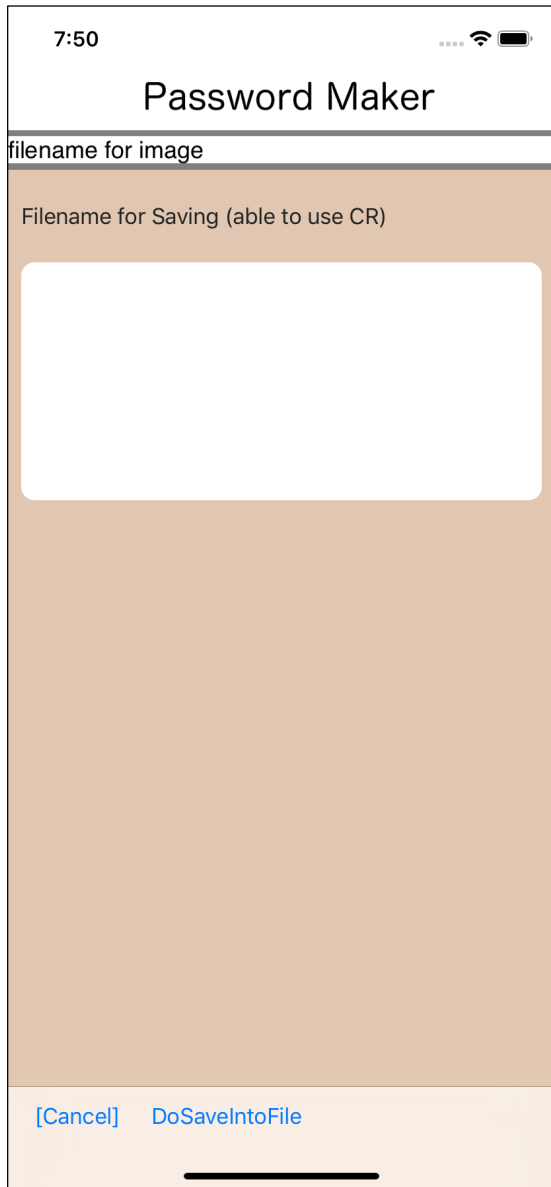
The figure on the left is just after being pasted.

This state is simply displaying the pasted image.

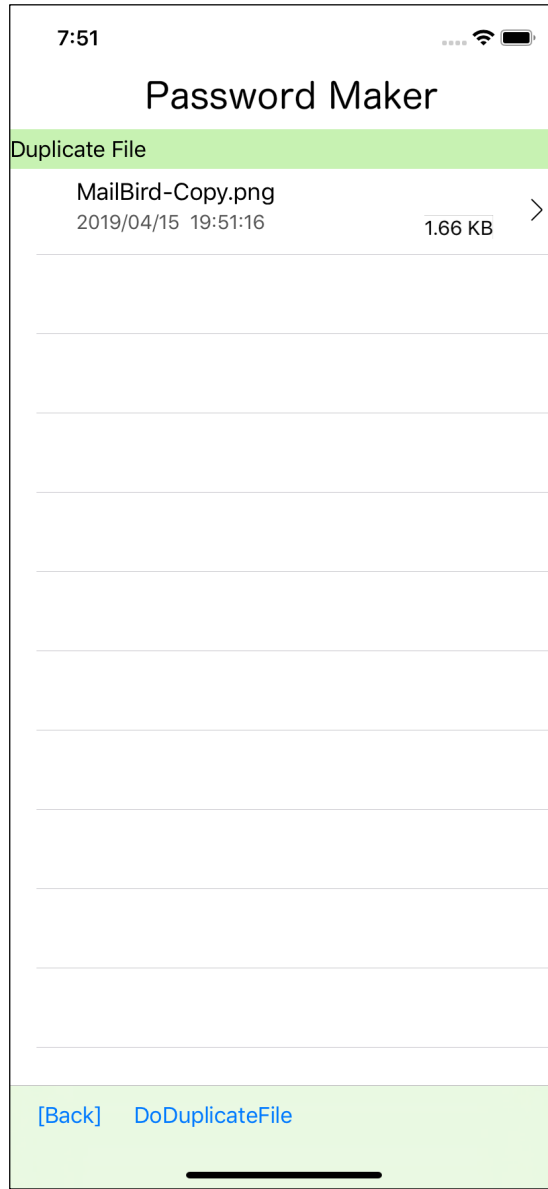
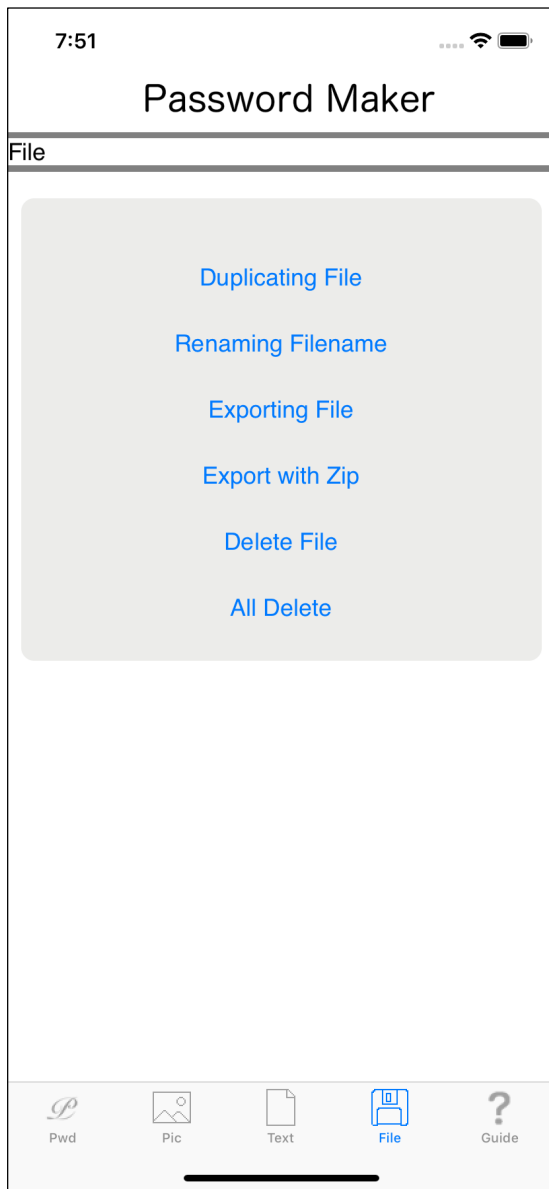
When you press the [Command] button on the toolbar, the pop-up menu as shown on the right pops up from the bottom.

This is the command for the displayed image.

When you click the "Save in File" button on the pop-up menu, the following view for entering a file name will appear.



In this way, when you enter the file name and press the "DoSaveIntoFile" button on the toolbar, it will be saved as a png file.



This is what happens when you use the "Duplicating File" command to see what you have saved in the file.
