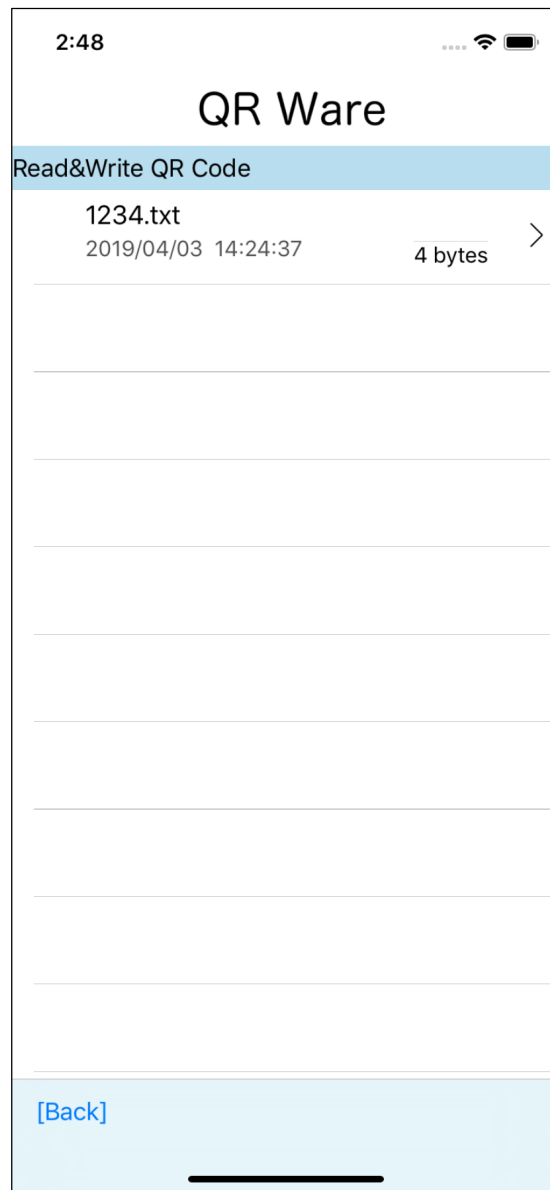
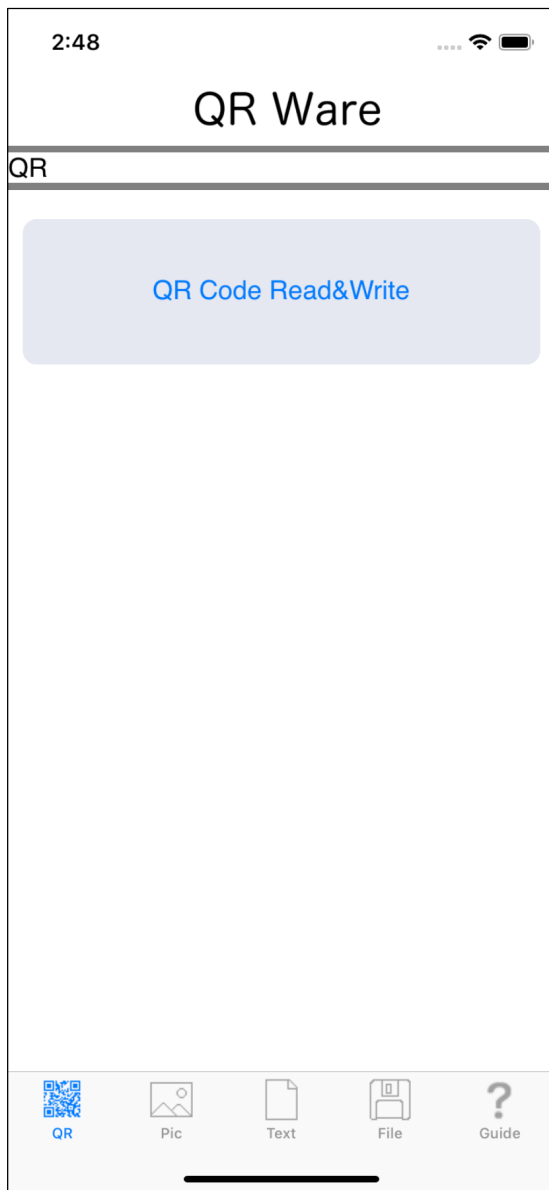
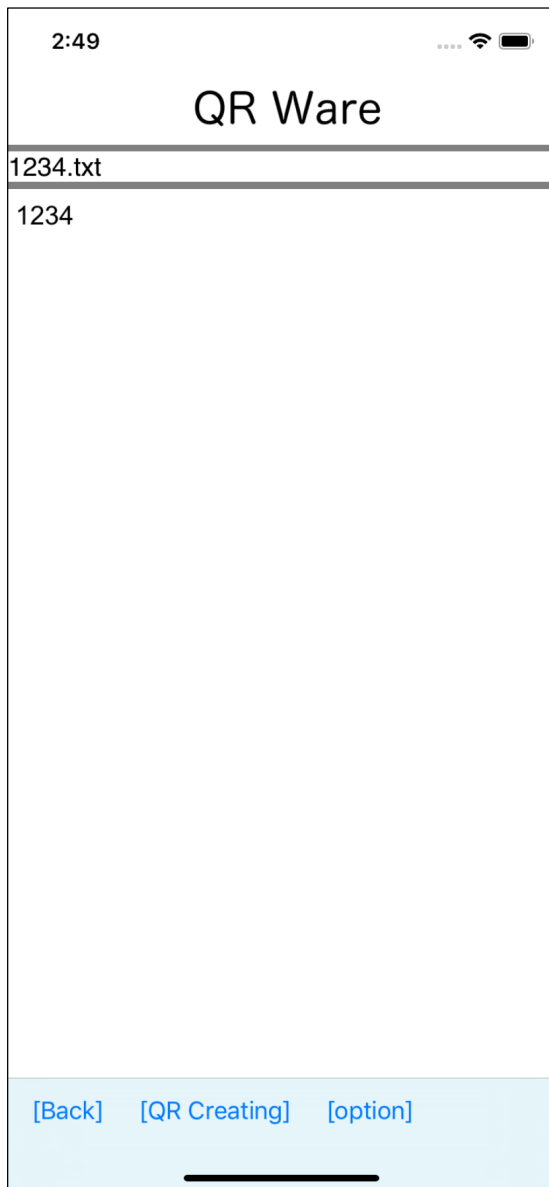


## Create QR code



When you press the main "QR Code Read & Write" button, a file name list view like the one on the right appears.

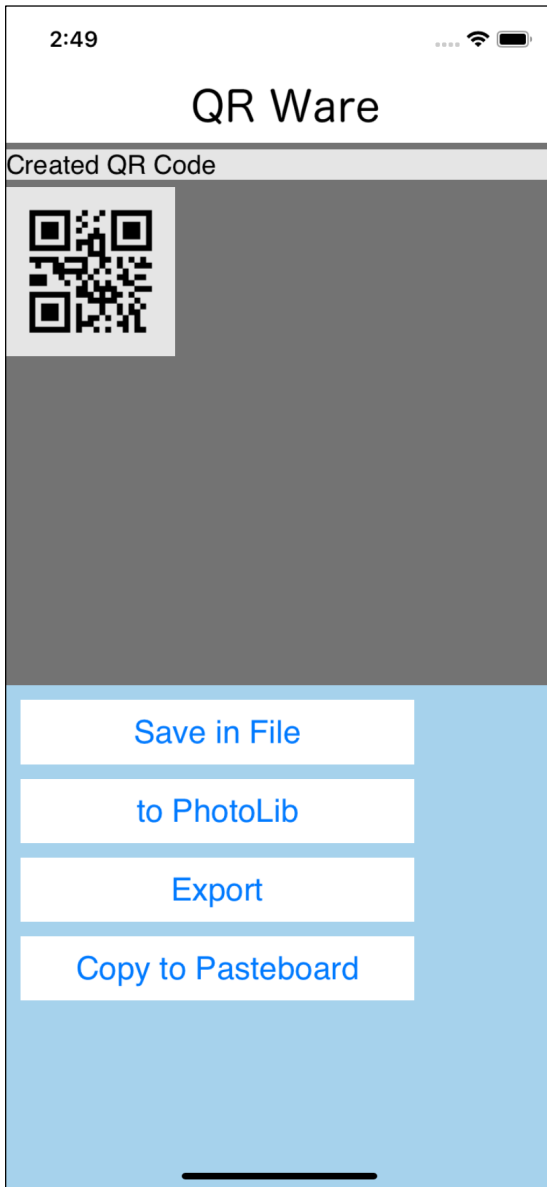
If you press the transition arrow of the file name list view, the contents of that file will be displayed as shown below.



When you press the “[QR Creating]” button on the toolbar of the view displaying the contents of this file, the contents are converted to QR code and the QR code image is displayed.

The QR code display view on the right just shows the image of the QR code at this stage.

When you press the “DoSave” button on the toolbar of the QR code view, a pop-up menu will appear from the bottom as shown below.



This pop-up menu shows what to do with the displayed QR code image.

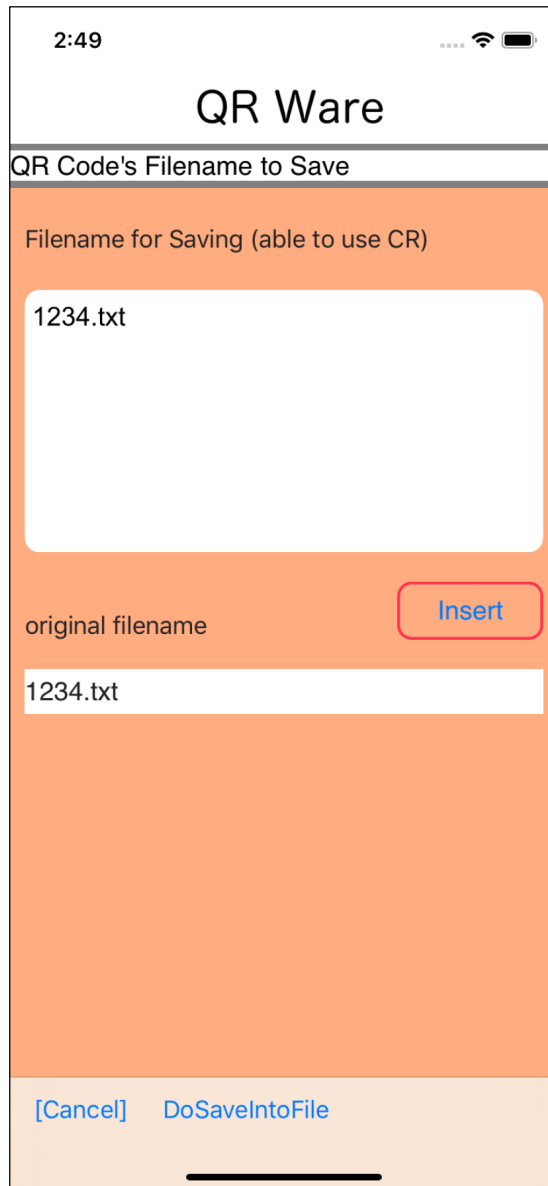

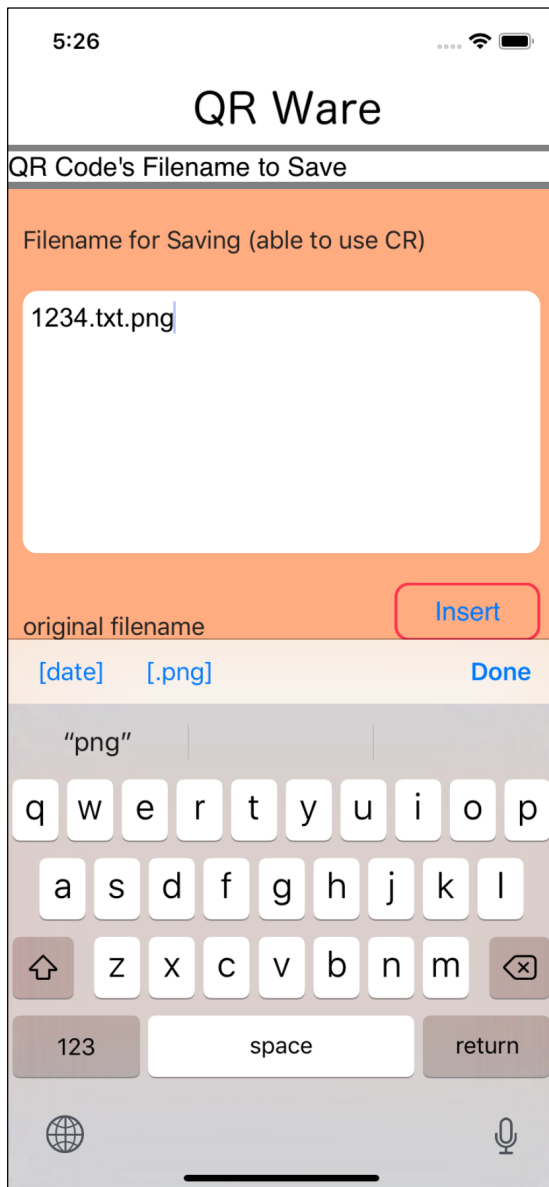
It is such a meaning.



When you press the Save in File button, a file name input view appears as shown on the left.

When the “Insert” button is pressed, the source file name is transferred to the text view.

You may enter an alias directly without pressing the “Insert” button.

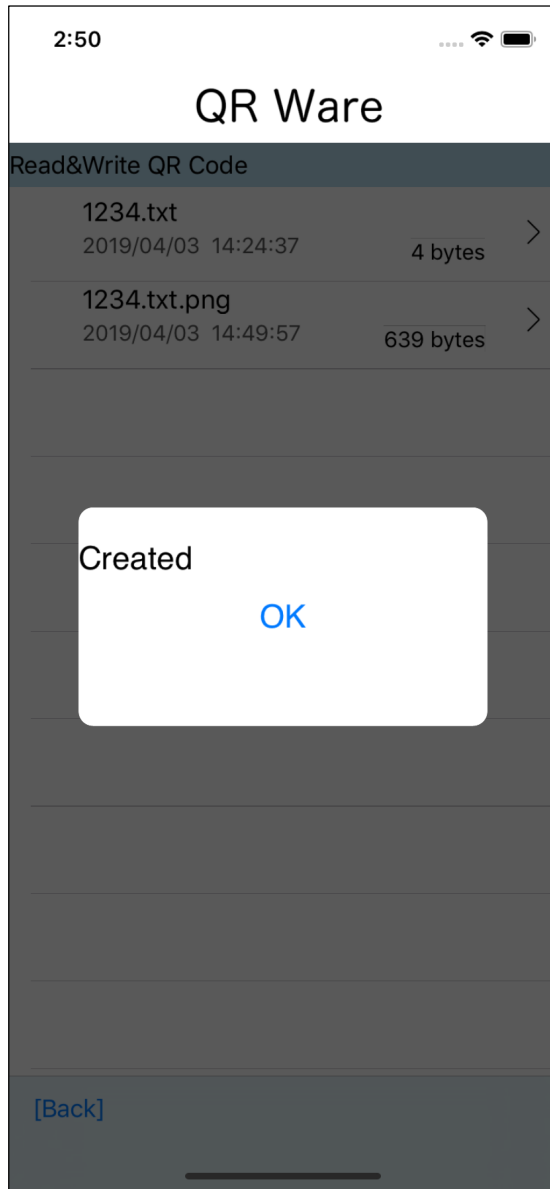


In this example, just ".png" is added to the end of the source file name like this.

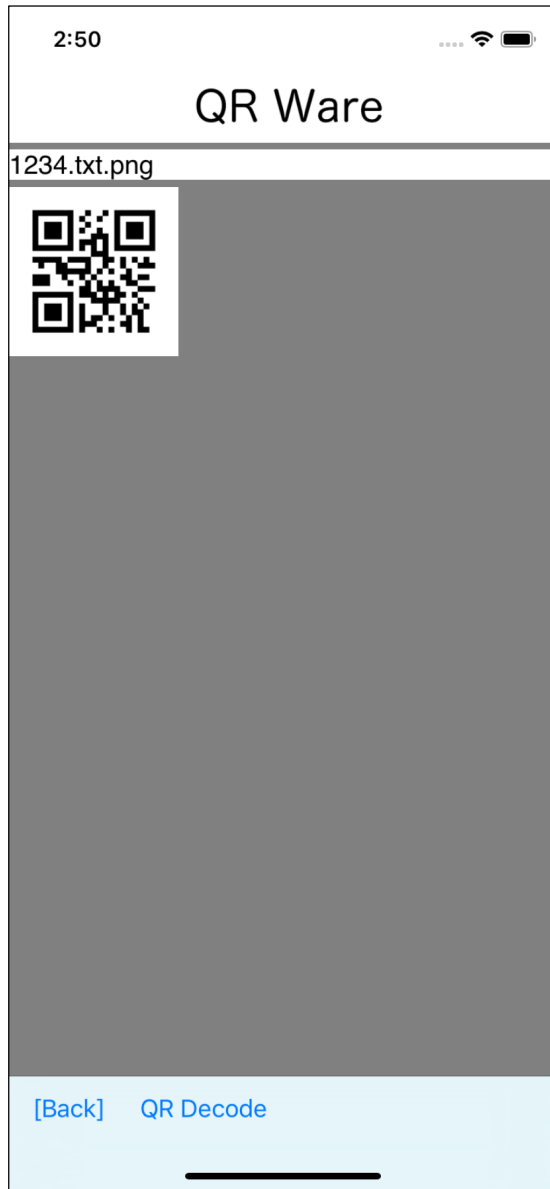
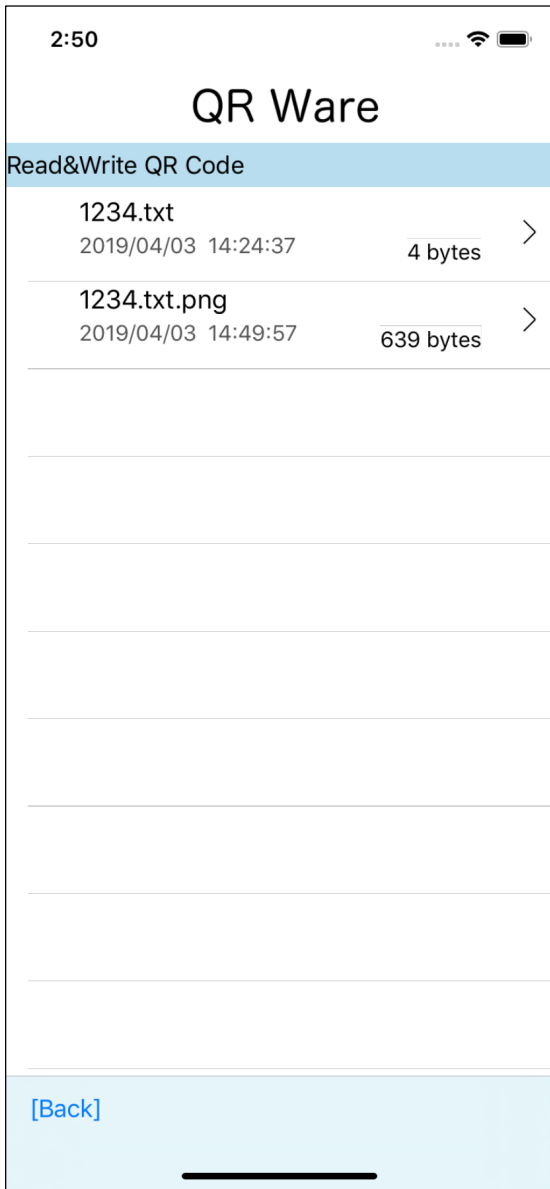
The extension is not required.

After entering the file name, press the “DoSaveIntoFile” button on the toolbar to save the QR code image as a file.
