rsac has nothing to do with iPhone/iOS, either in software or hardware.

rsac do not use any library code provided by Apple Inc. for cipher-related matters. Also, for cipher-related matters, iPhone/iOS functions, resources, etc. are not used at all for now.

There is no access to the iPhone/iOS keychain for both reading and writing.

So, whatever you do in rsac does not affect iPhone/iOS.

Also, rsac is not affected by iPhone/iOS.

The implementation of rsac about cipher-related matters is self-contained.

rsac is never affected by anything else.

Also, rsac does not affect anything else.

rsac is created according to the specifications such as NIST, PKCS, and RFC.

It passes the test vector of algorithm test distributed by NIST and IPA.
