X.509 certificate containing the public key pair with the private key used to create the signature

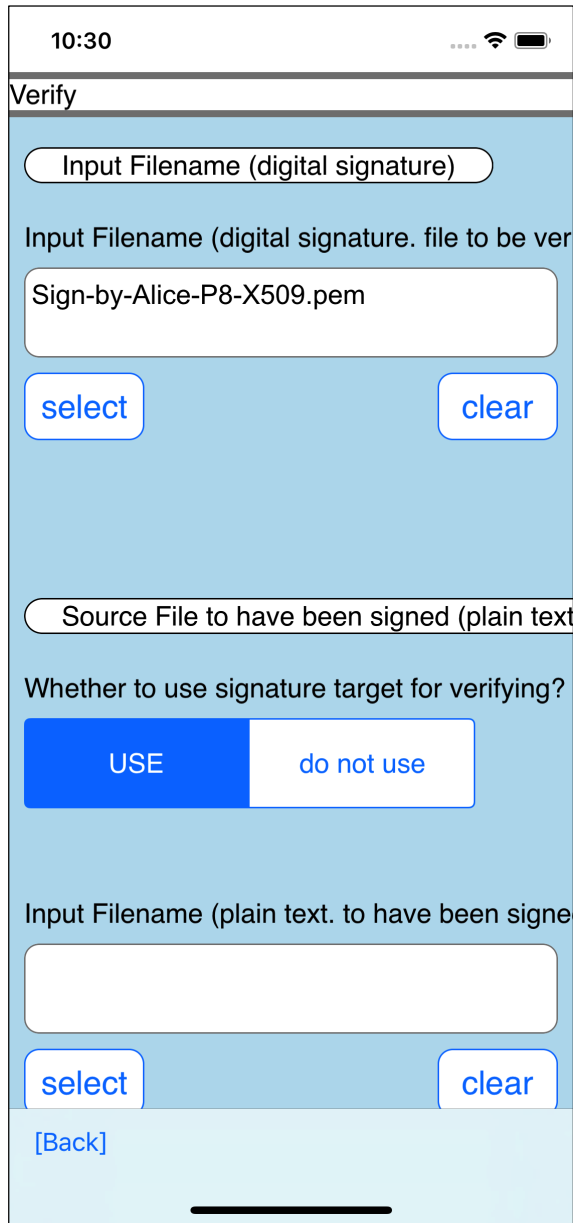
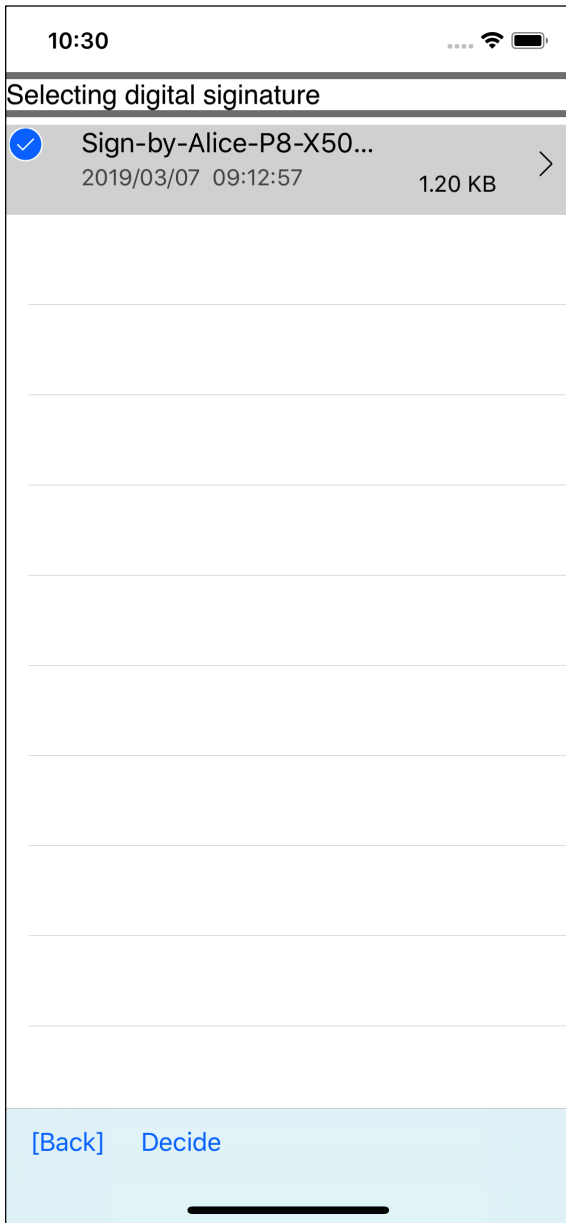


The example here is exactly the same as digital signature verification (1).
